Popular enough to have spawned a second location, the new Uchi spinoff has been aptly named "Uchiko, which loosely translated means "child of Uchi." Chef-owner Tyson Cole announced Monday that the second restaurant would open in a portion of space formerly known as the Seton Hospital Office Building at 4200 N. Lamar Blvd. He said he hopes to open the restaurant in the spring or summer of 2010.

"Uchiko will be Uchi in a new light. Identical to Uchi in almost every way, the new space will focus on a few changes that we would like to offer to our customers, but with the same incredible food and service," Cole said. "After 6 years of service in south Austin, Uchi is ready to grow."

Local designer Michael Hsu is once again at the helm, Hsu was the designer for Uchi as well. Uchiko will be divided into two separate rooms, the first being a dining room for walk-in customers and the second room for reservation-only seating. Ample parking is also a convenient perk of the new restaurant.

"I personally am so excited and I cannot wait to see what the future holds for all of us at Uchi in Austin," Cole said.
